


## SALUTE! A glass of wine for me, and one for you.

We have the red wine of the house *The Barbera D'Asti*, our fresh and immensely

popular sparkling *Spumante Brut*, the lovely *Rosato*, and last but not least our latest addition to the Villa La Madonna wine family, our sparkling *Rosé, Metodo Classico*. In addition to these wines made of the grapes grown by the villa, we also produce a fresh *Monferrato Bianco* from the local Arneis grape in cooperation with our friend and producer Claudio DaCasto.



## Barolo and Langhe Nebbiolo. These premium wines come in a very limited edition exclusively for Villa La Madonna and our guests, made in close collaboration with


We never get over the beginning of every new season when we welcome our new
