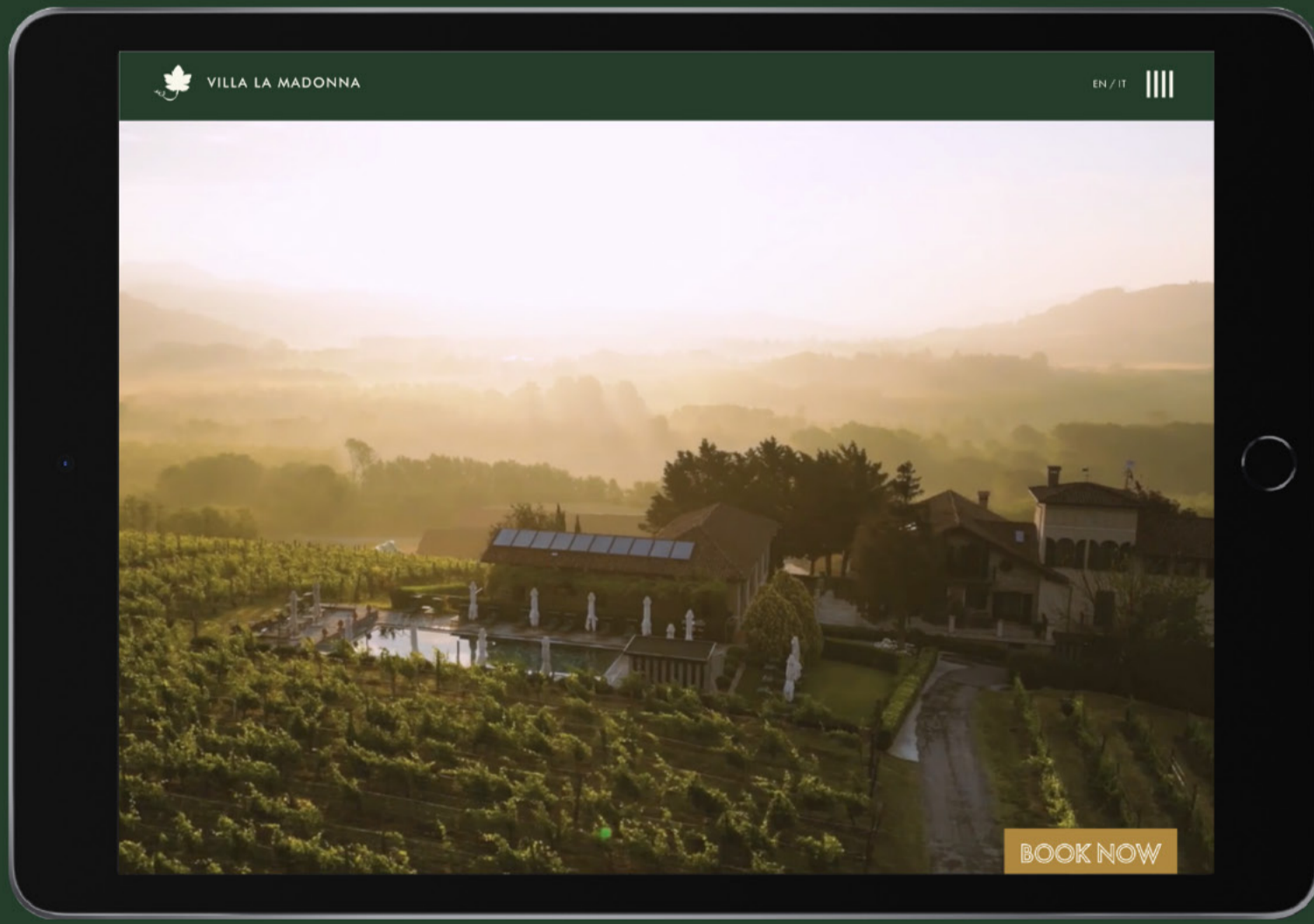
### Harvest and Hunts In All Its Glory, But...
